This past year has been astounding in its victories for life, including landmark state legislation to protect unborn babies and their mothers, record numbers of children rescued from certain death outside the Dallas abortion centers, and the largest crowds ever for the annual Roe Memorial events in our city.

We have come so far in our battle to uphold the sanctity of human life! Yet we are certainly not through.

Today, as we mark 41 years of legalized abortion in the United States, with the blood of 56 million unborn Americans staining our land, we must seize the momentum of 2013 and do still more to protect life.
